SOUTH DAKOTA EMS FOR CHILDREN PEDIATRIC EMERGENCY RESPONSE BAG



The EMS Pediatric Emergency Response Bag is provided by South Dakota EMS through funding from the South Dakota Department of Health Public Health Preparedness and Response Office. It is designed to carry all the essential first line equipment to assess and care for sick and injured children as outlined in the AAP/ACEP Joint Guidelines for BLS providers. ALS providers are asked to add the essential ALS equipment appropriate for their level of services. The pockets are color coded for quick identification of contents. We hope you enjoy this bag for years to come and your comments are always welcomed.

ALS Essential Equipment—Monitor/Defibrillator with adult/pediatric paddles and electrodes; Laryngoscope with straight blades 0-2; curved blades 2-4; Endotracheal tube stylettes; pediatric and adult sizes; Endotracheal tubes: uncuffed sizes 2.5-6.0, cuffed sizes 6.0-8.0; Magill forceps: pediatric and adult; Nasogastric tubes 8F-16F; Nebulizer; IV catheters; 16-24 gauge.

Equipment Organization:

Your EMS Pediatric Emergency Response Bag was designed by South Dakota EMS. Listed below are the suggested arrangements for storing the contents. You are free to add items to this bag, but in an effort to keep the bags uniform across the state, we ask that you follow the guidelines listed for all the essential items.
